A wide range of treatments and associated services

A specialist will work with you to select the most suitable treatment depending on the diagnosis and type of infertility discovered. Treatment is tailored to your individual needs.

We offer:

NHS funding

NHS treatment is available for some couples, but the amount of funding available and the eligibility criteria for treatment varies.

This is a package price per standard treatment cycle including consultations relating to treatment, HIV screening, medication, monitoring, early pregnancy monitoring, HFEA fees and counselling.

We have a team of experienced nurses, trained to a very high standard.

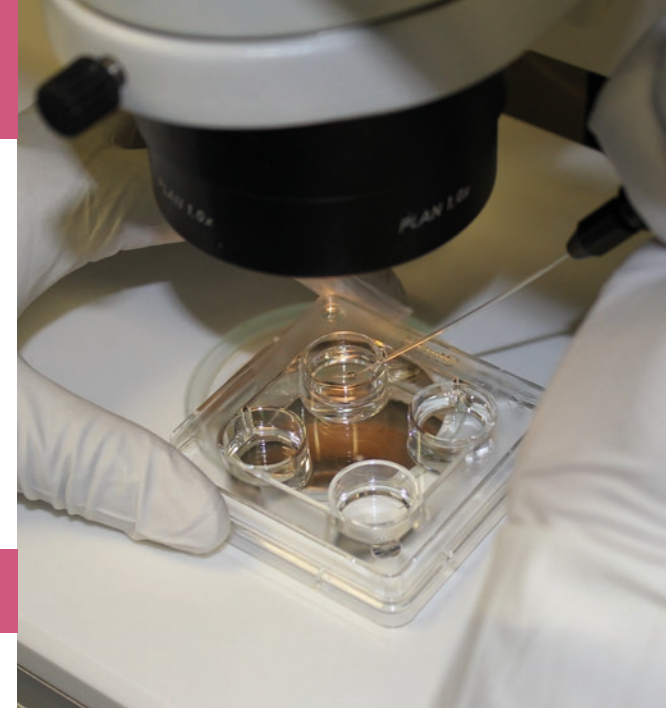
Our nurses are here to help and guide you through your treatment pathway, providing expert advice and support from the beginning of your journey to the end to ensure you receive the best care.

Advanced laboratories

In our laboratories we use state-of-the-art equipment, including the latest time-lapse technology, to monitor your embryos.

At Jessop Fertility we are committed to ensuring you have the best chance of a healthy baby, so we use single embryo transfer where appropriate. IVF Witness, a radio frequency tagging system is also used to ensure your eggs, sperm and embryos are safe whilst in our care.

We will aim to culture your embryos to the blastocyst stage (5-6 days old) to help us select the healthiest embryo for your transfer.
